Nassella tenuissima, commonly called Mexican Feather Grass is the most finetextured grass we can grow. With its wispy, flowing, lime-green foliage, the slightest breeze will cause it to sway. This cool-season native grass retains its color year round, although it may brown out somewhat in the heat of the summer. Light, wheatcolored seed heads emerge in May. Self-sowing can occur, so it's best used in managed landscapes where spreading can be controlled. Mexican Feather Grass requires dry soil and full sun, and it is very drought tolerant. Nassella tenuissima is especially spectacular planted in decorative containers. Suitable for mass plantings and erosion control.
